These incentives may be claimed directly through your 2023 tax filing. Seek additional guidance from your tax advisor. Here is a summary of some of the opportunities that may be available for you:

- Home Energy Efficiency Measures: Modified tax credits for efficiency improvements and whole-house energy saving retrofits, as well as high-efficiency electric appliance and non-appliance upgrades.
- Electric Vehicles: Incentives available for new and used electric vehicle purchases.
- Electric Vehicle Charging: Tax credits for installing a charging station at business or homeowner's residence if located in low-income or rural area.
- Clean Energy: Extends and modifies tax credits for the purchase of residential solar, solar water heating, fuel cells, geothermal heat pumps, small wind energy, biomass fuel and battery storage technology.

- \$150 for home energy audits.
- \$600 for other qualified energy property, including central air conditioners; electric panels and certain related equipment; natural gas, propane, or oil water heaters; oil furnaces; water boilers.
- \$2,000 for heat pumps and heat pump water heaters; biomass stoves and boilers.
