Smart meter facts

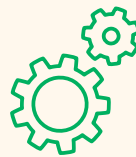
- Smart meters are safe.

Fewer estimates

Smart meters automatically measure hourly energy use, which means monthly bills are based on actual energy use.



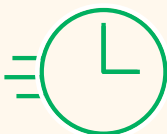
Automated meter readings

You no longer need to provide a meter reading or access to the meter to ensure your bill is based on actual energy use each month.



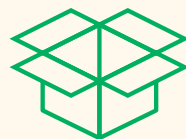
Fewer on-site visits

If you experience a power outage, your smart meter reports it automatically, allowing for faster diagnosis and quicker response.

In most cases, you can start or stop your electric service without scheduling a field visit.

What you can expect during your upgrade

You will receive a postcard several weeks ahead and an automated phone call in the days prior to our visit. You can prepare by making sure there is access to and a clear working space around your meter.
