Application addendum for phased projects

Document purpose

NYSEG and RG&E's Energy Efficiency and Beneficial Electrification Implementation Plan, filed in January 2026, requires the collection of information about electrification barriers and the support of customers on their journey toward full electrification. This document is part of the application and serves to collect that information for Phased Heating Electrification projects, meaning projects that do not include full load electrification of an entire building.

If to be used as emergency backup, provide control strategy to switch from heat pump to backup heat source.

If the whole building is not being electrified, describe why this project scope was chosen. What reasons did the customer provide for not pursuing electrification of other building areas/zones/systems at this time? Do they have plans to further electrify? Identify any further resources or support needed.
